# DECREE

Prot. N. 00792/03

Meeting on October 1, 2000, the General Minister, with the consent of his Definitory, made the following decisions:

- To establish a new Conference of Major Superiors in the sense of Const. 131, comprising the circumscriptions of the former APEF and the present EECC, KDP and PNVB Conferences.
- The new Conference will come into being on January 1, 2004 and will be known as the “Capuchin Conference of North-West Europe”, abbreviated as CENOC (Conferentia Europae Nordico-Occidentalis Capuccinorum).
- At its constitutive session, CENOC will adopt the Statutes and submit them to the General Minister for confirmation. Until that time, the Statutes provisionally drafted on September 27 in Rome will be used.
- With the consent of his Definitory, the General Minister entrusts Br. Ephrem Bucher, President of KDP, with the task of convening the first meeting of the Conference, which he will prepare with his secretariat and in consultation with the future members of the Conference. At this first meeting the Conference will elect a President, Vice-President and Secretary in accordance with the Statutes.
